

SSLC from Karnataka Secondary Education Examination Board

Student can appear for SSLC Examination as a private candidate. Course period is one year. Candidates can write the examinations either in Kannada or in English Medium. The examinations are conducted twice a year by the board. Eligible candidate should produce their Date of Birth Certificate.

Eligibility Criteria : Should have completed 16 years as on 1st March for the particular academic year (March\ April).

Required documents : (Any one of the following can be considered as date of Birth certificate along with 8 copies of Pass port size B/W Photographs).

1. Birth Certificate issued by the corporation / hospital
2. Transfer certificate containing date of birth.
3. Extract from admission register of school.
4. Affidavit.
5. Address Proof
