

## **B.A. AND B.COM. REGULAR BASIS AND OPEN UNIVERSITY BASIS**

B.A. and B.com . Degree Courses are offered in two schemes

- a) **Open University Scheme** (18 year of age as on 1<sup>st</sup> July of Academic year)
- b) **Regular Scheme** (PUC - II Pass)

### **Open University Scheme : B.A / B.COM**

Eligibility - Candidate who have completed 18 years of age.

**Eligibility Criteria** : 1. Candidates completed 18 years of age as On 1<sup>st</sup> July for the academic year are eligible for appearing first year of the course.

2. No previous qualification is prescribed.

3. The duration of the course is Three years.

**Required Documents** : 1. SSLC / SSC Marks card or Certificate / T.C. containing Date of Birth.

**OR**

2. Extract of Records (Admission Register) Maintained by the School

**OR**

3. Extract of Records maintained by Municipal and other local bodies or Any Government or Semi Government Institutions.

Medium of Instruction : English and Kannada

### **Regular Scheme B.A**

Eligibility Criteria : 1. Should have passed II PUC from Pre University Board (No age restriction)

2. Other State candidates should have Passed 10+2 or 12<sup>th</sup> Standard.

OR

Vocational Courses (Pre-University Examination) conducted by Government of Karnataka

### Regular Scheme B.Com

#### **Eligibility Criteria**

- : 1. Admission to the First year of the Three Year B.Com Degree programme is open to Candidates who have passed the Two year Pre-University Examination conducted by By the Board of Pre-University Education In Karnataka State.

Any other Examination considered as equivalent there to,

2. Candidates from other states who have Successfully completed 12 years of schooling (either 10+2 or 11+1 or Higher Secondary Examination - 12 years schooling excluding Nursery education)
3. Pre-University Education in Vocational Courses with relevant subject conducted by the Department of Vocational Education, Government of Karnataka.

#### **Direct Admission to Second year B.Com**

Candidates who have passed the Three year Diploma in Commercial or Secretarial Practice conducted by the Department of Technical Education, Government of Karnataka are eligible for admission to Second year B.Com. directly. However, they have to pass language papers and Indian Constitution, Human Rights and Environmental Studies- (ICHRES) of First year B.Com.

#### **Direct Admission to Final year B.Com**

Candidates who have passed the Three year Diploma in Business Administration conducted by the Department of Technical Education, Government of Karnataka are eligible for admission to Final year B.Com. However, they have to pass Language papers and Indian Constitution, Human Rights and Environmental Studies - (ICHRES) and FCA of First and Second year B.Com. before completing Final year B.Com. Such students will have to compulsorily study and pass all the papers of Final B.Com, Examination.

## Admission to II and Final Year B.A. / B.Com

1. Candidates seeking enrolment for Second or Third year B.A / B.com Programme shall Pay prescribed Programme / Tuition Fee not later than last date announced in the particular academic year.
2. Candidates seeking admission directly to Second and Final B.A./B.Com will have to study ICHRES OF 1<sup>ST</sup> Year and Fundamentals of Computer application of Second B.A / B.Com in addition to the subject in second and final year B.A respectively and pass the examination.

Candidates admitted to First Year B.A / B.Com Programme are eligible for promotion to Second Year even if she/he fails or not appeared for any or all the papers of First Year. She/he is eligible for promotion to Final Year if she/he fails or not appeared for any or all the papers of First Year and Second Year.

## Other Information

1. The maximum duration for the completion of B.A/B.Com Programme shall not exceed two times the duration (Six years) of the particular Programme from the date of admission to the Programme (including the year of admission).
2. Candidates who discontinue their studies for more than four academic years after joining a Programme shall have to seek fresh admission.

## Duration of the Programme

The minimum duration of B.A / B.Com. Programme is Three Years and maximum is Six Years from the Year of Admission. The Candidates who do not complete the Programme within Six Years will have to seek fresh admission.
